If you cannot attend your hygienist appointment a minimum of 48 hours notice is required otherwise you may incur a failure fee of the full cost of the appointment.

Our receptionists and dental nurses complete the dedicated team who are all committed to providing the very best dental care service.

Treatment Options

Private treatment is offered on a pay-as-you go basis or under Denplan Care scheme. We will give an estimate of charges and keep you fully informed of any changes with a view to discussing further treatment together.

Private treatment allows the use of high quality materials and convenient appointment times. NHS treatment is available for children under the age of 18 years old or full time students under the age of 19 years old.

Cosmetic Dentistry

The practice offers a wide range of cosmetic dentistry, this includes; crowns, veneers, bleaching, implants and many other corrective techniques.
